

TITLE IX ATHLETICS – OCR/ED’s THREE FINDINGS ENCOMPASSING 13 PROGRAM AREAS REVIEWED FOR COMPLIANCE

FINDING I – ACCOMMODATION OF INTERESTS AND ABILITIES

1. Three-Part Test:
 - 1) participation proportionate to full-time undergraduate enrollment; or
 - 2) continuing program expansion for underrepresented sex; or
 - 3) fully accommodate underrepresented sex.
- Two-Part Test:
 - 1) equivalent levels of competition; or
 - 2) upgrade competitive levels.

FINDING II – ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS

2. Scholarship dollars to be awarded to women and men at same proportion as their respective rates of participation in the intercollegiate athletics program.

FINDING III – OTHER ATHLETIC BENEFITS AND OPPORTUNITIES

3. **EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES** – Quality; amount; suitability; availability; maintenance and replacement.
4. **SCHEDULING OF GAMES AND PRACTICE TIMES** – Number of games; number, length, and time of practices; game times; pre-season and post-season opportunities; season length.
5. **TRAVEL AND PER DIEM ALLOWANCES** – Modes of transportation; housing and dining/per diem during travel; length of stay before and after competitive events.
6. **TUTORING** – Availability – hours, locations tutors are available; Assignment – qualifications, training, experience; Compensation – rate of pay.
7. **COACHING** – Availability – number of coaches per team; lengths of contract; full-time, part-time assistance, and graduate assistant status; non-coaching responsibilities; Assignment (qualifications) - years of coaching and success; Compensation – salary and related compensation.
8. **LOCKER ROOMS, PRACTICE AND COMPETITIVE FACILITIES** – Quality, availability, maintenance and exclusivity of competitive, practice and locker room facilities; preparation of practice and competitive facilities.
9. **MEDICAL AND TRAINING FACILITIES AND SERVICES** – Availability of medical personnel; availability and qualifications of athletics trainers; availability and quality of training rooms and weight rooms; insurance for athletics participation.
10. **HOUSING AND DINING FACILITIES AND SERVICES** – Housing and dining for the regular academic year; housing and dining for term breaks; special housing; pre-game and post-game meals.
11. **PUBLICITY** – Availability and quality of sports information personnel; quantity and quality of publications; other publicity and promotional services.
12. **SUPPORT SERVICES** – Administrative, secretarial, clerical support; office space and equipment.
13. **RECRUITMENT OF STUDENT ATHLETES** – Equal opportunities to recruit; equivalently adequate financial and other resources; equivalent treatment of prospective student-athletes.
